

## Spring Fair Cakewalk

**THE CAKEWALK:** The cakewalk is one of the most popular events at the festivals. For those of you new or unfamiliar with the Cakewalk, here's how it works: Music is played, when it stops everyone stands on a number (Much like musical chairs though EVERYONE gets a number spot). A large dice is then rolled and whoever is standing on that number wins the prize – the cake (or baked good) of their choice!

**WHAT TO PLEDGE:** IT DOES NOT HAVE TO BE A CAKE – BROWNIES, CUPCAKES, COOKIES, ETC. Non-cake items should be grouped to be equivalent to a cake please. Remember – NO PEANUTS. This applies to purchased items also. Be sure ingredients are listed; if not, we cannot use the item.

**THE CONTEST:** Please pledge to bring in a baked good (home-baked or purchased). The class that brings in the most goodies will WIN A CHOCOLATE FOUNTAIN PARTY!

**HOW TO PLEDGE:** PLEASE fill in the following pledge, and send it in your child's backpack to: Spring Fair/cakewalk. If you have multiple children, please use SEPARATE pledge sheets. Then **bring the item(s) you have pledged to the school on Friday, March 12th, between 12:00 and 2:00 p.m. or on SATURDAY morning at the start of the festival.** Be sure to mark your item with **your child's name, grade and homeroom so they will get credit for the item.**

## Spring Fair Treasure Jars

**WHAT ARE TREASURE JARS?** Treasure Jars is a game the kids can play at the Spring Festival. Each child rolls a dice. If they get an even number they win their choice from the Treasure Jars (the larger the number rolled, the larger the jar they can pick). An odd number wins a prize ticket.

**HOW CAN YOU HELP?** WE NEED JARS OF GOODIES!!! Just like the Cakewalk, this game will not be successful without your help. Even though it is called 'Treasure Jars' you can use ANYTHING to hold your goodies; sports bottles, plastic bottles or containers, empty plastic mayo jars, etc. – use your imagination! And fill them with any items you like- it doesn't have to be limited to just candy. Small, inexpensive toys, hair accessories, stickers, tattoos, etc. will work. Again, be creative! **IMPORTANT:** Please be considerate of our fellow students with nut allergies and do not use peanut butter jars or medicine jars and avoid food/candy with peanuts! NO GLASS JARS, please.

**THE CONTEST:** For EACH filled jar (or container) you bring in, please label it with a label from below. BE SURE THE LABEL WILL COME OFF EASILY. We will collect the labels off the jars. The classroom with the most donations will win an ICE CREAM SUNDAE PARTY!

**WHERE TO BRING THE JARS:** Baskets for jar collections are located in every homeroom. We will be **accepting jars until Friday, March 5th.** Be sure the jars are covered (especially if it contains a food item!). **Empty Jars and Containers can also be contributed.**
